If you haven't heard of Camp Bovey, then start asking around, because many of us in Northeast Minneapolis have priceless memories of this special place. For over 60 years it has been the summer destination for children of low-income families in Northeast and the metro area. Located in Gordon, WI on 200 beautiful acres with sprawling pines and a private lake, it is a picture perfect example of a classic American summer camp.

Despite its picturesque scene Bovey has fallen on hard times. The camp has been in a spending freeze since 2009, leaving no funds for repair and maintenance. Worse yet, the members of the Lions Club who previously took care of the upkeep have matured to the point where they can no longer keep back the ravages of nature and time. These factors have left Camp Bovey in need of serious maintenance.

But fear not! The men of Arcana Lodge #187, the Northeast Minneapolis chapter of the Freemasons of Minnesota have taken up the call.

With a very generous materials donation from Siwek Lumber Co., help from Josh and Alex Siwek , and support from local contractor Cory Smith of CKS LLC, Arcana Lodge was able to send a group to do repairs.



Over a weekend of volunteering Arcana volunteers were able to; install fire escape ladders for the cabins, replace a fence around the swimming area, build storage containers for trash and beach supplies, and replace rotted boards on the deck.

Camp Bovey is again looking as great as it feels when you're there. With Arcana's continued commitment to Camp Bovey, for the great things it does for the children of Northeast Minneapolis, the camp will continue to do its good work for another 60 years and longer.

## Secretary & Trustee's Report

Greetings Brethren,

The Arcana Lodge Board of Trustees has reviewed several bids to replace the roof on the lodge building. As you can see in the picture to the right, the leaking roof has caused significant damage to the lodge room ceiling. We received a bid of \$36,000 to repair the East half of the roof, the section that is posing the most problems (the roof over the lodge room.) We've also received bids from \$51,000 - \$80,000 to replace the whole roof. It's the Trustee's recommendation that we should to replace the whole roof.

The Board of Trustees, to comply with the Arcana By-Laws Article III, Section 10, will submit a resolution at the Arcana Stated meeting on July 8, 2013 requesting approval from the Lodge to contract the roof repair and in agreement with Minnesota Masonic Code section G13.27 request approval from the Grand Master for a building expense in excess of \$20,000. Additionally we will request that the Lodge apply for a \$20,000 loan from the Grand Lodge under section G3.05 of the Minnesota Masonic Code. These resolutions will require a final vote at our stated meeting on July 22, 2013, and we invite all interested members to attend that meeting so your concerns may be heard, and your vote counted.

Thanks to a very generous bequest we received from an Arcana member who answered the roll call of the Great Architect of the Universe several years ago we were able to establish an investment fund for Arcana thru the Grand Lodge. Drawing down the principal in that fund, along with a \$20,000 loan from the Grand Lodge, and all the generous

donations we've received in the past several months for the Arcana **Building Renewal Fund** we can afford doing the roof repair at this time. However, that will leave us in very precarious situation of being left with limited funds on hand for unexpected expenses, maintenance and emergencies.

The bottom line is that we need to raise more money. One approach we're going to take is to send letters to all the local Masonic Lodges, and local Concordant and Appendant Masonic bodies to advise them of the availability at Arcana Lodge should they be in search of a new meeting location. We will offer them a discount on rent if they are able to pay for ten years in advance to help Arcana fund these building improvements.

Another fundraiser we are going to reestablish is the Arcana Minute Men Pancake Breakfast. This Fall on October 6<sup>th</sup> we will be holding the first Pancake Breakfast at Arcana in decades. As with the Spaghetti dinner we will be mailing out tickets in advance to our members. We especially encourage our local members to sell those tickets at your church, to your friends, and your co-workers. We will be providing a flyer with each letter for you to display at your church or have included in your church bulletin on the day of the breakfast. Of course we will also welcome your generous donations if you are not able to attend.

Next year Arcana Lodge will be 125 years old. With your continued support we will be here on the corner of Central & Lowry in Northeast Minneapolis for another 125 years!
